

TOWN OF FORT NELSON
THE MUNICIPAL TICKET INFORMATION
BYLAW NO. 610, 2002

August 2002

A bylaw of the Town of Fort Nelson (hereinafter called "the Town") to implement a municipal ticketing information system.

WHEREAS Section 272(1) of the Local Government Act authorizes the Council to, by bylaw, designate a bylaw that comes within a category of bylaws prescribed under section 280(b) of the Act; designate as a bylaw enforcement officer a person who comes within a class of persons prescribed under section 280(c) of the Act; and, authorize the use of any word or expression on a ticket issued under section 272 of the Act to designate an offence against a bylaw, for the purpose of enforcing said bylaws by means of laying an information by means of a ticket for contravention of the bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. CITATION

- (1) This bylaw may be cited as "The Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 610, 2002".

2. REPEALS

- (1) The following bylaw is hereby repealed in its entirety:
 - (a) The Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 550, 1998.

3. APPLICATION

- (1) This bylaw shall apply to the geographic area of the Town of Fort Nelson.
- (2) The bylaws listed in Column I of "Schedule A" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw are the designated bylaws for the purpose of Section 272 of the Local Government Act.

- (3) The persons appointed to the positions or titles shown in Column II of "Schedule A" of this bylaw are designated as "Bylaw Enforcement Officers" for the purpose of enforcing the bylaw shown opposite that position in Column I of "Schedule A".
- (4) The words or expressions in Column I of "Schedule B", "Schedule C", "Schedule D", "Schedule E" and "Schedule F", all of which are attached hereto and form part of this bylaw, may be used on a ticket issued under Section 272 of the Act to designate the offence against the Section of the bylaw shown opposite that expression in Column II of that schedule.
- (5) The amount shown in Column III of "Schedule B", "Schedule C", "Schedule D", "Schedule E" and "Schedule F" is the fine set under Section 272(5) for contravention of the Section of the bylaw shown opposite that amount in Column I of that schedule.

4. SEVERABILITY

- (1) If any portion of this bylaw is held to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the bylaw.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE

- (1) This bylaw shall take effect upon its adoption.
